China Itinerary

Day 1 * New York/Beijing

Board an afternoon flight by 3:30 pm to Beijing. Fly Trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jet-liner. Cross the International Dateline.

Day2 * Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China at 6 pm. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Transfer to the hotel after dinner.

Day 3 * Beijing

Visit the Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world, and the Temple of Heaven. Sightseeing also includes the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, and the Summer Palace.

Day 4 * Beijing

Excursion to the Great Wall. The 4,000-mile long and 2,000 year old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by the naked eye from the moon. Visit to the Ming Tombs before dining on a Roasted Beijing Duck Dinner.

Day 5 * Beijing/Shanghai/Suzhou

Spend the morning in Beijing and the afternoon sightseeing in Shanghai and Suzhou including the Linger Garden, Tiger Hill, Hanshan Temple, and the National Embroidery Institute. Enjoy an evening dinner show of the traditional Chinese music.

Day 6 * Suzhou/Hangzhou

Morning tour bus journey to Hangzhou to visit the Economic Development Zone and the centuries old Lingyin Temple.

Day 7 * Hangzhou/Shanghai

Morning boat cruise on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses. Afternoon tour bus trip to Shanghai.

Day 8 * Shanghai

Sightseeing includes the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees. Visit to the Bund, a famous waterfront park. Business visit to the Pudong economic development zone.

Day 9 * Shanghai/Beijing/New York

Morning flight to Beijing. Afternoon flight will depart by 1 pm for JFK
